World Cup 2026 at St Mary's



We are looking forward to enjoying the world cup with the children at school.

We already have our World Cup flags bunting up in the KS2 hall and children will have the opportunity to take part in a daily 'whose flag is this' quiz in class.

Classes have a wall chart to record the scores of each match and there will be lots of lovely maths discussions around what data we can collect, and how the information can be displayed in different ways.

We have also produced a quiz for each class to do with questions such as: 'Who is the oldest / youngest player?'; 'Who scored the first goal in the competition?'; 'What was the quickest goal scored?'

We are also very grateful for the donation of 2 football goals from a parent which we hope to have in use soon (once it stops raining!).



School Meals

After consultation with the local authority, the cost of a school meal will increase to £2.80 from September 2026

The proposed increase reflects the continued pressures on catering services, including food inflation, currently projected at 3.1% up to the end of 2026, alongside sustained increases in utility and operational costs. We continue to work closely with our procurement team through regular contract review meetings to monitor and manage these pressures as effectively as possible.

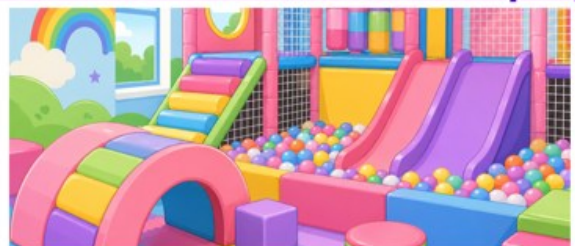

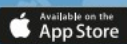
