







We used the Christian Aid Letters for Creation resource pack as a starting point and some stories about trees...





























I would include something about the world and how we need to start acting to make a change

For my letter of creation I would include climate justice because it is not join that some people aren't coming about the earth and peoples homes are getting washed away.


In my letter for creation, my message would be to help the environment and reuse / recycle more.


















It was also St Mary's 'Walk to School Week' organised by the Junior Travel Ambassadors. These are some of the class trees made by children walking to school.


