




**Matthew 13:31-33**




### Brazil nut farming


1. What is the population of Bolivia?
2. What is the landscape like?
3. How many layers make up the rainforest? What are the layers called?
4. How do the gatherers collect the Brazil nuts?

11. Name two things the extra money from Fairtrade has been spent on.

1. The population of Bolivia is 10.8 million.
2. Most of the landscape is covered in rainforests and lush environments.
3. The layers are the Forest floor, The understorey, The canopy and the Emergent layer.
4. The Brazil nut can only be collected from the wild. Gatherers go on collection trips, camping in the rainforest for days or weeks at a time.
5. The seed capsules can fall from the the floor and some can weigh as much as a large pineapple. If the wild changes gatherers have to stop collecting the Brazil nut pods and move away from the trees.
6. Back in the communities, the Brazil nuts are stored in wooden huts called pilones.
7. The rainy season starts at the end of gathering season so it is a race against time to pack and transport the Brazil nuts.
8. As the co-operative the Brazil nuts are dried on a wooden floor and go on to the factory to be cracked and packaged. Selling as part of a Fairtrade co-operative means that the gatherers can get a better price for their hard work.
9. The areas are very rural so communication between gathering communities is difficult. The flooding at the end of the gathering season can make it hard to ship and transport the nuts.
10. By working together as a fairtrade co-operative the gatherers can sell more Brazil nuts at a better price.
11. The extra money is spent on medicine, tools, cars, and opportunities for their children to go to school.
