# Road Safety News from the Junior Travel Ambassadors

## Green Cross Code Week May 5<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>



### THE GREEN CROSS CODE

A thorough knowledge of the Green Cross Code is vitally important to primary school children **over 7 years:**

1. First find a safe place to cross
2. Stop just before you get to the kerb
3. Look all around for traffic and listen
4. If traffic is coming, let it pass, look all around again and listen
5. When it is safe go straight across the road - do not run
6. Keep looking and listening for traffic while you cross

### STOP - LOOK - LISTEN



## The Green cross code

1. **Think first**  
Find a safe place to cross then stop

2. **Stop** ☆  
Stand on the pavement near the kerb ☆

3. **Use your eyes and ears**  
Look all around for traffic and listen ☆

4. **Wait till it's safe to cross**  
If traffic is coming let it pass - look all around again ☆

5. **Look and listen again**  
When there's no traffic near walk straight across the road

6. **Arrive alive** - Keep looking and listening for traffic while you cross
