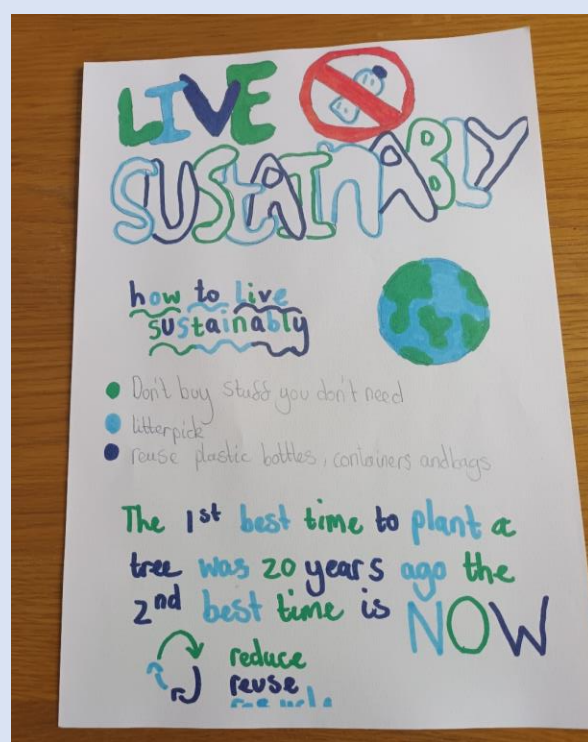
- Saving food for another meal

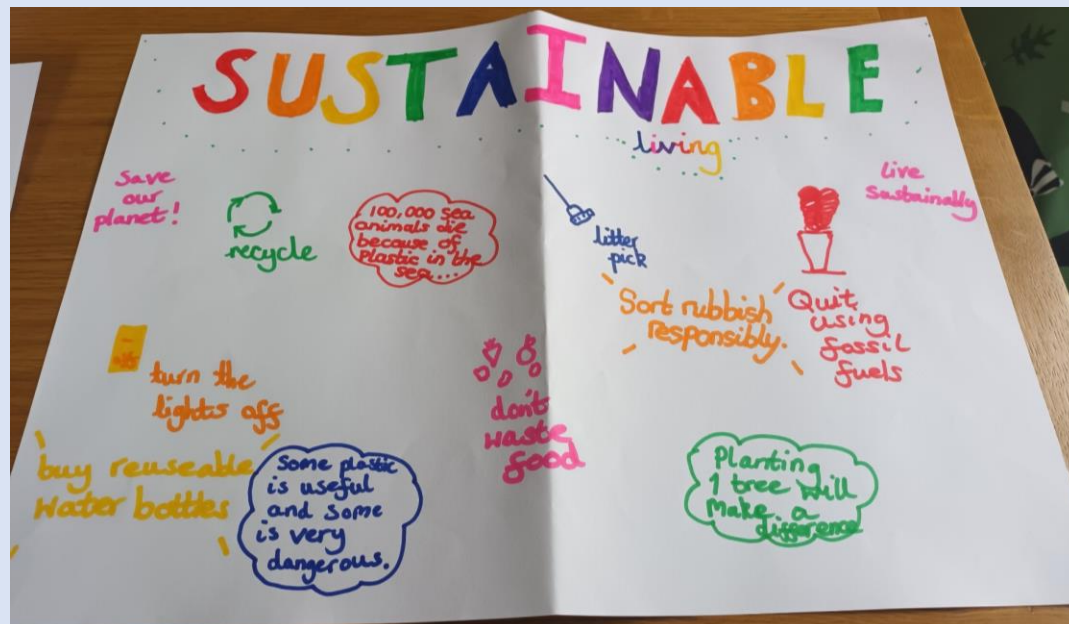
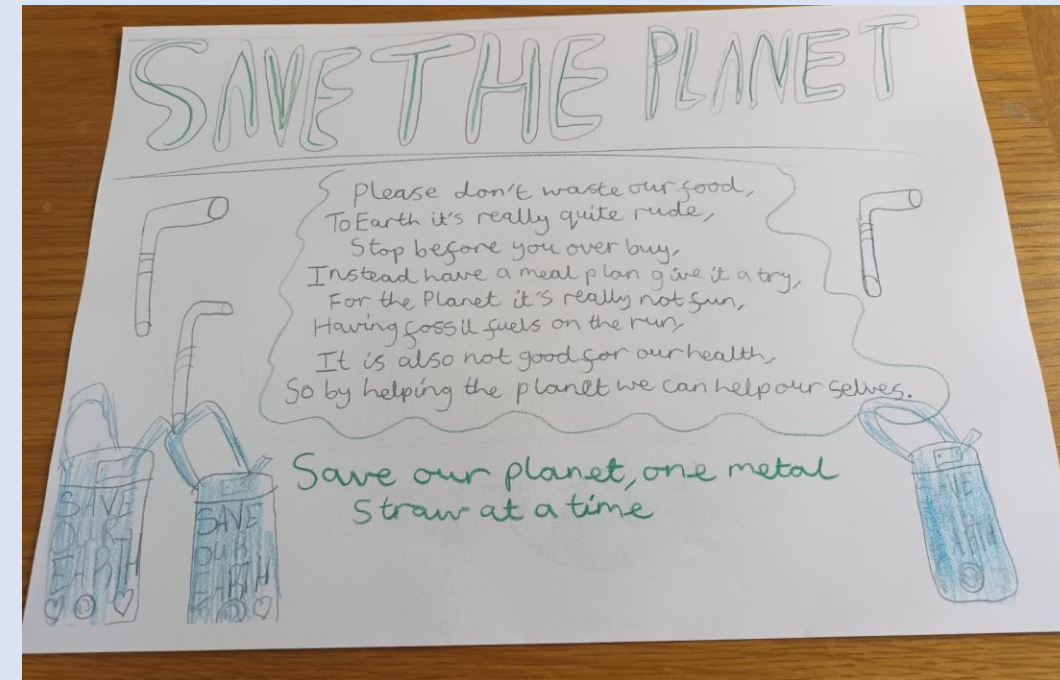

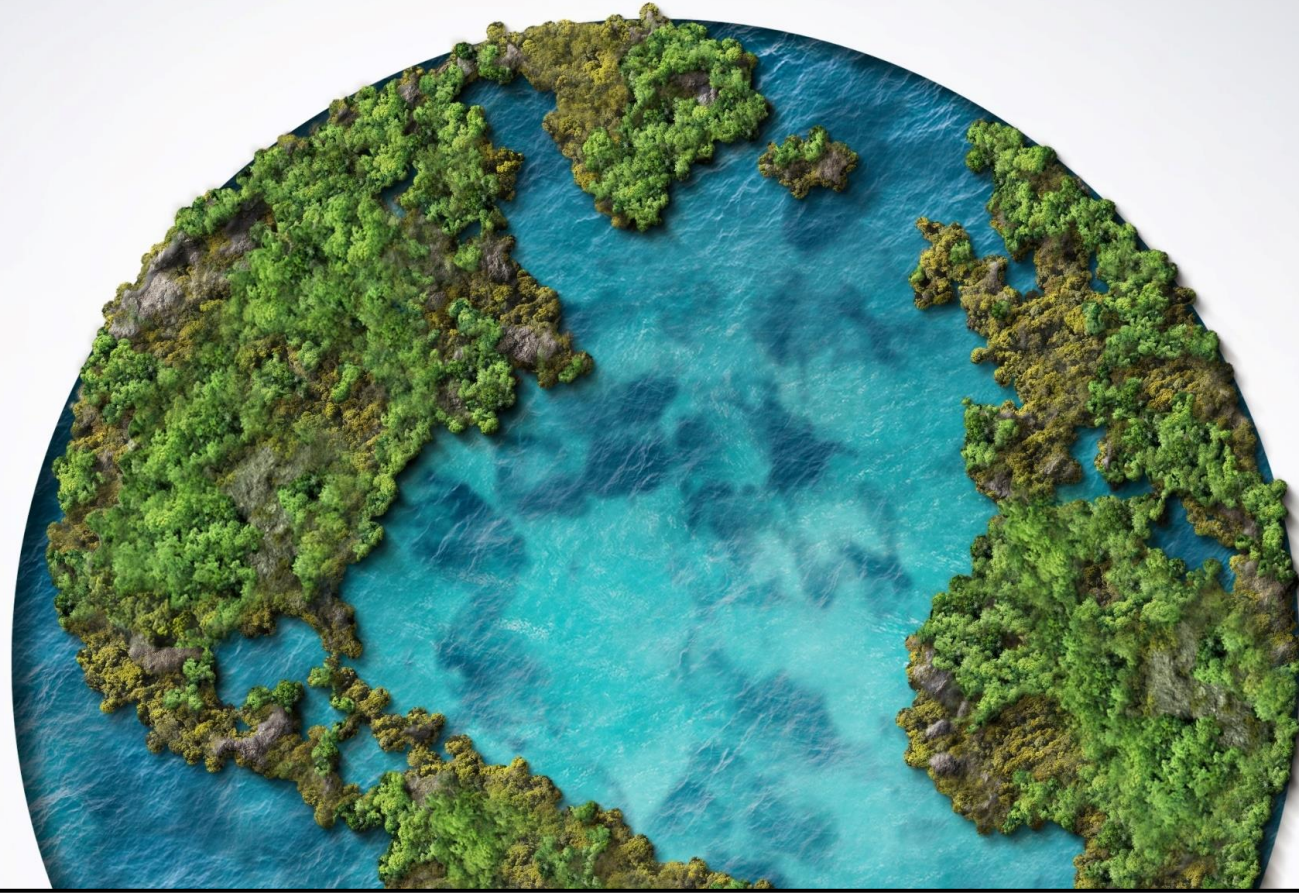
